



SASB Seeks to Improve Sustainability Standards in the Apparel, Accessories and Footwear Industries

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In light of an industry coalescence around a commitment to sustainable sourcing of raw materials, the Sustainability Accounting Standards Board (SASB) on February 25, 2020 unanimously approved a standard-setting project for sourcing by the apparel, accessories and footwear sector. The goal of the project is to clarify and improve metrics in current SASB standards.
